

## Pond Memo Q&A with Pond Professionals

We would like to thank all of the residents who attended the recent Q&A session with Pond Professionals that was held on June 18, 2026. We appreciate everyone taking the time to participate and ask questions.

The presentation was very informative, and the representative from Pond Professionals took a methodical approach in addressing resident concerns and answering questions. One of the most important topics discussed was aquatic herbicide applications. He explained that the frequency and timing of treatments are governed by county, state, and federal rules and regulations, and all applications must comply with those requirements.

The discussion also included the aquatic vegetation currently being managed in ponds 13, 17, 20, and 22. A key takeaway from the meeting was that the lack of natural rainfall continues to be the biggest challenge affecting pond conditions. While management and vendors can implement maintenance and treatment plans, many environmental conditions ultimately depend on Mother Nature and adequate rainfall.
